Para. 21 Club Colours

The matter of the correct colour and design for the Club tie was brought to the attention of the meeting. Major NH Macaulay stated that the approved tie had been designed by Col. Hanson and himself and that the tie was originally manufactured by Gibb & Co., but that he could not say whether the stripe ran from left to right or vice- versa. The matter could, however, be decided by looking into the arrangements made with Gibb & Co.

It was moved by Brigadier WB Anderson and seconded by LCol Hanson “ that the matter of which way the stripe on the Club tie ran be ascertained by the incoming Executive Committee.”
